# 1. Culture Moves Europe

....is the new permanent **mobility** scheme

....funded by the **Creative Europe** programme and implemented by the **Goethe-Institut**.

It offers **mobility grants**

....to **artists, cultural professionals** and **host organisations**

....residing in and going to any **Creative Europe country**

....working in the **sectors** of architecture, cultural heritage, design and fashion design, literary translation, music, visual arts and performing arts.

....It aims to foster **sustainable and inclusive** mobility in the cultural sector

....and will give particular attention to **emerging creators**.





**€21 million budget!**



**7000 grantees by 2025!**

### 3. Individual Mobility Action

*Who can apply?*

**Individuals**

*ell* **Mobility duration: 7 to 60 days**

**Groups**  
Up to 5 people

*ell* **Mobility duration: 7 to 21 days**



**Call open from 10 October  
2022 until 31 May 2023!**

In 2023: from September 2023 to May 2024.  
In 2024: from September 2024 to February 2025.





# Call for individual artists and cultural professionals

## What are the conditions to apply?

- **18+**
- **Legal resident of a Creative Europe country** (Albania, Austria, Armenia, Belgium, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Kosovo, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Netherlands, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Tunisia, Ukraine)
- Applications in **English language** (proficiency not evaluated)
- Maximum of 1 application per person for this call.
- **Beneficiaries from i-Portunus grant are eligible** but not prioritised
- **Beneficiaries from the Culture Moves Europe will not be eligible** to apply again
- Support **not** awarded **retrospectively**
- Applicants legally residing in **Ukraine** are allowed to directly apply for **virtual mobility**



# Call for individual artists and cultural professionals

## What for?

To develop a project with an international partner

→ 1 project, 1 partner, 1 destination

The aim of this project can be:

- **To explore:** To explore Europe's rich cultural heritage to inform, direct or inspire their own creativity
- **To create:** To co-create or co-develop art with A&CPs from other countries
- **To learn:** To participate in non-formal learning
- **To connect:** To develop or deepen international professional relationships

# Call for individual artists and cultural professionals

## What is an international partner?

The project to be developed needs to be with an **international partner**.

Who can be:

- A fellow artist
- An organisation
- A venue, etc.

You will need to provide proof of the partnership, with e.g

- Invitation letter
- Confirmation of meeting,
- Co-production agreement, contract, etc.

## What sectors?

All cultural and creative sectors from the Culture Strand:

- \*Architecture
- \*Cultural heritage
- \*Design and fashion design
- \*Literary translation
- \*Music
- \*Performing arts
- \*Visual arts



# Call for individual artists and cultural professionals

## What are the mobility conditions?

- **Uninterrupted** mobility
- Mobility to a **single destination**
- Must take place **within 1 year** from the signature of the grant agreement
- **Activity report** must be filled in within 2 weeks after coming back
- Possibility to change is limited to **force majeure** situations

# Call for individual artists: how much?

## The mobility grant

### A.1. Travel:

- The distance is calculated from the place of residence to the place of destination (one way)
- Travel fee for round-trip

Distance	Standard fee	Explanations	Compulsory proof
Less than 600 km	350€	Travelling by plane is not allowed - except exceptional cases: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You have a disability;</li> <li>• Your residence country/destination country is an island and ferry connexions do not exist;</li> <li>• You are under a force majeure or grave personal circumstances case.</li> </ul>	Green transport proof will be requested and checked
601 - 5.000 km	350€	Applicants will have two options:	If 'Green travel': proof of green travel will be requested and checked
from 5.001 km	700€	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>To 'travel green':</b> to support sustainable way of travelling, A&amp;CP can request a green top-up of 350€ if they take any transport other than airplane to go from the place of residence to destination.</li> <li>• <b>To travel by plane:</b> For A&amp;CP who can only travel by plane, a contribution to the Co2 compensation fund, Atmosfair, will be paid by Culture Moves Europe on behalf of the grantee.</li> </ul>	Proof of transport tickets will be requested and checked

### A.2. Daily allowance: Contributes to accommodation, food, renting equipment, local transport, etc.

Per A&CP	75€ / Day	Proof of the exact number of days of the mobility will be requested and checked

## 4. Call for individual artists: how much?

### The top-ups

B. Extra costs and top-ups		Requested proof
<b>B.1. Support for A&amp;CP living with a disability</b>	The budget should be agreed with the Culture Moves Europe team and can amount up to 100% of the mobility grant.	Detailed budget of needs requested
<b>B.2. Green top-up : all transports except airplane</b>	350€	Green transport proof compulsory and checked
<b>B.3 Outermost Regions (ORs) and Overseas Countries and Territories (OCTs) top-up</b>	150€	Transport ticket to or from an OCTs or ORs compulsory and checked
<b>B.4 Visa top-up</b>	80€	Visa proof compulsory and checked
<b>B.5 Family support for A&amp;CP with young children below the age of 10</b>	100€/A&CP, regardless of the number of children.	Family proof compulsory and checked



# Applicants residing in Ukraine

Applicants legally residing in Ukraine will exceptionally have the option to apply for a virtual mobility.

Grant for applicants residing in Ukraine			Requested proof
Option 1	Physical mobility	Calculation for physical mobility financial support applies (see 2.2)	Proofs for physical mobility apply
Option 2	Virtual mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No travel costs nor top-ups</li> <li>35€ daily allowance to cover subsistence, connectivity, etc.</li> </ul>	Proof of legal residence in Ukraine, duration of the mobility and some deliverables from the virtual project

## 4. Residency Action

### Who can apply?

Organisations and individual established artists wishing to host artists at their residency project

### Duration

Mobility duration: 21 up to 300 days (10 months)

### Sectors

Architecture, Cultural heritage Design and fashion design, Literary translation, Music, Performing arts, Visual arts

### When?

Call for residencies hosts launch Mid-March 2023
